Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been made aware of a number of new apps and games that students are downloading and playing on their phones and devices. We wanted to take this opportunity to flag these with you in order that you can check the apps and games they are using and ensure that they are using them safely. Most recently we have been made aware of an app called AmongUs where young people have ended up chatting with strangers who have turned out to be unknown adults trying to hook them into conversations.

We would like to encourage you to have regular conversations with your children about their internet usage and particularly the apps they are using and the safety measures they have in place to protect them. Please spend some time familiarising yourself with these so that you are then able to have informed conversations with your children about how they can use these responsibly and safely. We will continue to prioritise E-safety as part of our curriculum in ICT as well as PSHE and tutor time.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you about the BBC 'Own It' app, which supports students with moderating their internet usage. This is particularly prevalent given this week is 'Anti-Bullying Week'. One of the features of this app is a keyboard which will help them with prompts and reminders about the content of what they are typing and also flag support to them if they type something worrying.
