Applications for the academic year 2022-2023 are now open. Applications for 2023-24 will open in September 2022, please apply using our Nursery Application Form after this date.

If you wish to submit a late application for the 2021-22 academic year, please contact Mrs Greaves in the Academy office.

Our purpose-built nursery is an intrinsic part of our Early Years Foundations Stage provision. We offer outstanding experienced, highly qualified teaching and support staff and a safe, secure and caring environment. The wide range of exciting learning activities on offer nurtures your child's innate curiosity, develops their skills in English and mathematics, expands their knowledge of the world around them and supports them to develop a range of character strengths and virtues.

With a focus on developing key learning attributes and dispositions and of course our DARE values of determination, aspiration, respect and enthusiasm, the Nursery is the perfect preparation for further learning at King's Academy Binfield.

Children become eligible for 15 hours a week free provision from the start of the school year following their third birthday. This means that you may apply for a place for your child in our nursery for the September, following their third birthday.

We will have 33 places initially in our nursery and are offering 14 part-time places (morning or afternoon) and 19 full time places – for which the 20 additional hours will be charged. If you are eligible for a 30 hour funded place, you will only be charged for 5 additional hours per week. In addition, all full time children may be charged for a hot meal each day. Costs for 2022/2023 will be £7.50 per hour or £30.00 per day.

Children taking up a full time place will arrive at 8.30am and be collected at 3.30pm. Those attending the morning session will arrive at 8.30am and be collected at 11.30am. Children attending the afternoon session will arrive at 12.30pm and be collected at 3.30pm. Before applying, please check the table overleaf to make sure your child is the right age.
