Head of Primary News:

It has been a shorter than normal week this week due to our INSET day tomorrow but so much learning has been fitted into the short week. The academies are buzzing with preparation for the Christmas Shows and we are hopeful that we will be able to invite you all into the Academies to watch your child's performance. We will of course keep you up to date if we need to make any changes in regards to this.

Attendance Letters

This week we received direct contact from the Secretary of State for Education, Nadhim Zahawi, asking us to play a vital role in supporting raising the attendance of children within our Academies. Mr Zahawi has asked schools to: 'communicate clear and consistent expectations around attendance to families and work with your LA, making full use of enforcement actions where appropriate.'

As you will know from parent talks and open evenings, attendance is very important to us and we have an aspirational target of 97% attendance across KAB and KAO. This week, you may have received an attendance letter from us if your child's attendance is below 95%.

As stated in the attendance letter, whilst we completely understand that there could well be good reasons for the absence we do have a duty to flag this with parents and support families to achieve attendance of above 95% and towards our target of 97%.

If a child is extremely ill, of course they will not be well enough to be in school and some illnesses such as sickness require 48 hours out of school. Other children may require more medical appointments for their individual needs and again we completely understand this. However, we have many parents keeping children off for reasons such as being tired or having a slight headache/earache etc. In these circumstances please bring your children into school and we will monitor them, contacting you if needed.

Letters are sent out to all who are below 95% attendance to raise awareness to families and to offer support should it be needed. If you know that sadly, your child has been unlucky with illness this term, please do not be too concerned about the letter as you will have valid reasons for them being absent.

I hope this reassures those of you who emailed in and provides clarity.

The children have also started practising their own weather report using the knowledge they have about Autumn and Winter. We are all very excited about recording the weather reports next week!
