

Behaviour, Expectations and DARE Points



Children are rewarded DARE points for showing our values. These points add up to individual, whole class and house awards.

Individual points:

- Water only in drinks bottles, if this is an issue for your child please talk to one of us



Homework will be set using Spelling Shed. Which is accessible either as an app or online.



Times Tables

In Year 4, all students will sit the National Multiplication Check in June.

Multiplication Tables Check

This activity exactly mirrors the 'Multiplication Tables Check' that will be given to children at the end of Year 4. They are tested on their multiplication tables up to 12 x 12. There are twenty-five questions and children have six seconds to answer each question and three seconds between questions. The questions are generated randomly using the same rules as the 'Multiplication Tables Check' (see below).

Results can be downloaded and printed at the end of the test.






Addition and Subtraction




