The second 2 weeks of the Summer Term have seen a tutor time and whole school focus on #cultureofkindness. Oxbridge Talk and Careers - Mrs Richards

We were really excited to welcome Amelia Griggs from Cambridge University on Thursday 12th May to speak to students in year 10 and a group of students from year 9, about the opportunities that Oxbridge universities offer. This is part of a larger set of activities, lessons and events that we are planning with our students to get them thinking about what their future holds. We want to show our pupils the importance of really engaging with the decisions that they make about what to study, the skills they may need and the experiences that they can gain that will help them in the future. Our pupils heard about the opportunities that are available to students, what life is like at university and what you could expect from your time there. Students also had the opportunity to ask questions about anything relating to studying at Oxford or Cambridge University.

As a follow up to this, students used their PSHE lesson on Friday 13th May to explore their A level options. Depending on whether students knew what they wanted to do for a career or study at university, or not, they either worked backwards from a potential career pathway, or forwards from their interests and strengths, to see

which A level / post-16 study choices would be a good fit for them. We strongly encourage students who have any questions relating to any part of their future studies to speak with their tutor about their options.
