Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you all for your support with students who were not able to come to school this week because of the strike. I hope students were able to continue their learning at home as effectively as possible. The next strike days will be on 15 and 16 March 2023. I will be in touch closer to the time with information about the provision we will have in place on strike days 3 and 4.

Year 11 have completed two weeks of Pre Public Exams. All year 11 students have been working hard and have been focussed throughout the exam period. We will be supporting students to use feedback effectively in the coming weeks as they prepare for their final GCSE examinations. We will also be reviewing arrangements and reflecting on the logistics of the exams with students as well, which will help us to improve arrangements ready for exams in the summer.
