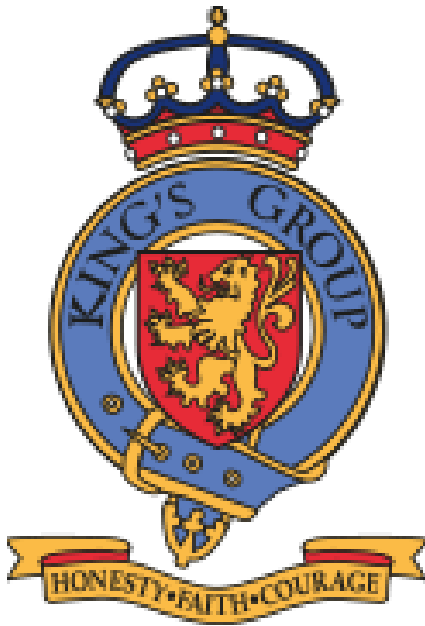
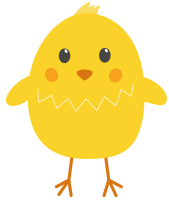

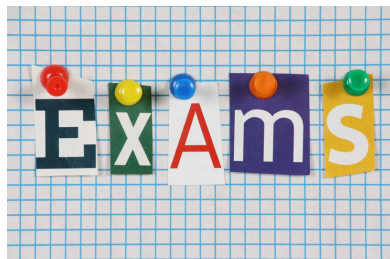
MESSAGE FROM MRS MOORE

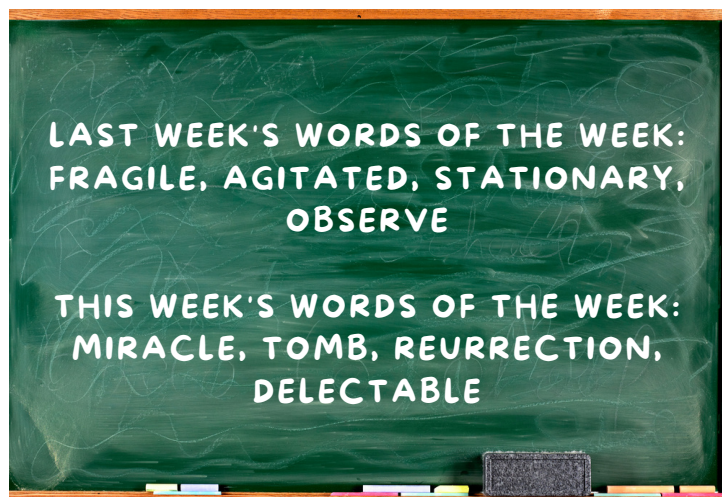


NURSERY & RECEPTION UPDATES

EMERALD CLASS

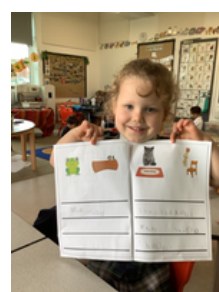

NURSERY & RECEPTION UPDATES

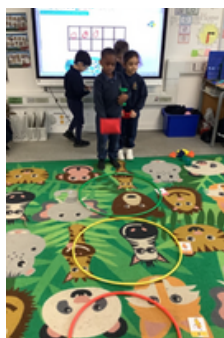
JADE CLASS

YEAR 9 MOCK TRIAL COMPETITION



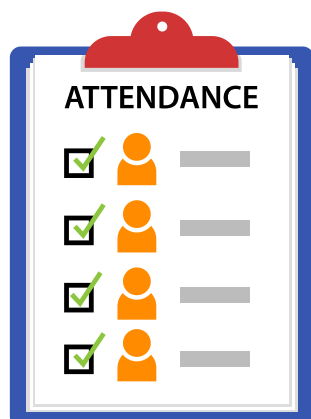
