Please can I emphasise that, Secondary drop-off and pick-up is via the Wood Lane car parks or at the Forest Road drop-off car park at the end of the alley by the playing fields. Secondary students should not be dropped off or collected from St Georges Park. Please park away from the school, students should walk the last part of their journey.
