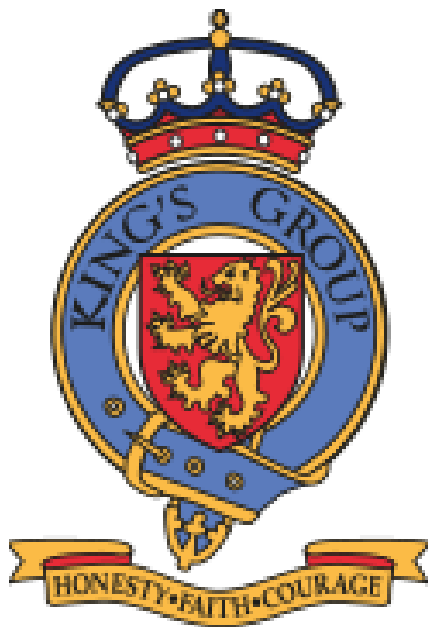

Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to share with you some of the activities that have been going on in our school this week.

### Open Evening and Open Mornings

Last week we hosted our annual open evening for Year 5 students and their parents and carers. Despite the torrential rain that evening, we had three packed presentations in the main hall and lots of people touring the school. The 'mud' cakes in Food Technology seemed to be a big hit!
