



Consultation on proposed Admission Arrangements for King's Academy Binfield for entry in September 2027

Introduction

King's Academy Binfield is an academy school and is its own admission authority. When an admission authority wishes to make changes to their admission arrangements, they must consult to ensure all views are heard. King's Group Academies is consulting on the following changes to their admission arrangements:

Proposed changes to the oversubscription criteria:

- Adding King's Academy Meadow Vale as a linked primary academy.

Why are we proposing these changes?

We are consulting on a proposed change to the King's Academy Binfield (KAB) admissions policy. The proposal is to give priority in admissions to pupils currently attending King's Academy Meadow Vale (KAMV).

The rationale for this change is rooted in the unique relationship between King's Academy Binfield, King's Academy Oakwood, and King's Academy Meadow Vale. As part of King's Group Academies Multi-Academy Trust, these schools work in close partnership and are designed to provide pupils with a coherent, high-quality all-through educational experience.

This proposed change reflects the Trust's commitment to deepening the quality and impact of our existing provision. The context for this change is specific to King's Academy Meadow Vale.
