Level 3 Subject Tasters A Level, BTEC and CTEC 3rd-7th November

To help students gain a deeper understanding of the subjects available at King's Academy Sixth Form we will be offering subject taster sessions during tutor time, the week beginning November 3rd. These sessions will provide students with the opportunity to experience Level 3 teaching and ask questions directly to subject teachers. We would encourage all Year 11 students to engage fully with these sessions, as this will assist them in making confident, well-informed decisions about their future studies and next steps.

Sessions will last for 25 minutes, and students will have an opportunity to experience up to 4 different subjects. We would really recommend students consider trialling a subject they are curious about and might not have experienced before; or a subject that they have yet to decide is right for their next steps. Students have been making their selections during tutor time this week, so please do ask them about what they are considering. You may even encourage them to look further ahead at university courses they might already be thinking about, or a potential career, and get them to explore if there are any subjects that are non-negotiable upon application (for instance, A level Biology for Medicine).
