At Key stage 4 all students complete the EBacc subjects which allows them to study a broad range of subjects. This means that all students must study:

- English Language,
- English Literature,
- Maths,
- Science (either combined science or separate sciences)
- A language (either French or Spanish)*
- A humanities subject (either Geography or History)

In addition to this, students will choose two GCSE subjects from:

- A second language (either French or Spanish)
- A second humanity (History or Geography)
- Further Maths & Statistics
- Computing
- Dance
- Drama
- Music
- PE (GCSE or OCR National)
- Art and Design: Fine Art
- Art and Design: Textiles

- Art and Design: Photography
- Design Technology
- Food and Nutrition
- Religious Studies
- Media Studies
- Business Studies (GCSE or Enterprise BTEC)

*Students who do triple science will have 12 periods of Science and 2 periods of PE a fortnight

**Whilst we aspire that all students will study these subjects, a small number of students may not take a language where we have sufficient educational reasons to limit their pathway.
